<Students>

•Please check and record your temperature at the site of temperature measurement, and touch the card reader with your student card to record your entry.

Those who enter Building #1, 2, 3, 6:

At the site of temperature measurement located at the 1st floor, Building #3.

Those who enter Building #4:

At the site of temperature measurement located at the 2nd floor, Building #4.

Those who enter Building #5:

At the site of temperature measurement located at the at the 1st floor, Building #5 (Entrance facing the intersection).

- •If your have a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, you will not be allowed to enter the campus. You should go home and rest or consult with a medical institution.
- •Students who come to campus by bicycle, please park it in the designated parking area (next to Building #1) and enter from the site of temperature measurement at Building #3. (Notes) Students cannot enter from Building #1.
- *You do not need to take your temperature when you leave the campus.

<Faculty and staff>

- •Please enter from the side gate beside Building #1 and check your temperature.
- •If you have a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher before you leave home, stay home and rest or consult with a medical institution.

<Those who are outside of the university>

•Please enter the campus as the same way students do and check your temperature.

*You do not need to take your temperature when you leave the campus.
