Project Overview



- The purpose of this research is to construct a personnel training program to acquire knowledge and skills necessary for the global social work based on the values and ethics of social work.
- People who have been well trained to develop social work globally will become talented social workers and finally contribute to people's happiness through activities including restoring or acquiring human rights, supporting in daily life for those foreigners working both in Japan and abroad.
- Note that this program includes the "Multicultural Symbiosis Social Work" course, which will be launched in 2018.

To advance the project

- Since this project aims to produce global talented workers, so overseas training is essential. Many organizations conducting overseas social work have great achievements. One of them is the outstanding NPO Kamonohashi Project, which succeeded in sharply reducing the trafficking in Cambodia. In this program, students will learn on-site about the efforts that the Kamonohashi Project carried out so far.
