Musashisakai Station : Exit North side, take bus #5 for Mitaka Station or Musashino Eigyocho. Approx. 7 min. to Musashino University.

Mitaka Station : Exit North side, take bus #3 for Musashino University, Musashi-Sakai Station, Musashi-Koganei Station or Vi Gardern Nishi Tokyo. Approx. 10 min. to Musashino University.

Kichijoji Station : Exit North side, take bus #1 for Mukodai-cho 5-chome or Sakurazutsumi Danchi. Approx. 15min. to Musashino University.

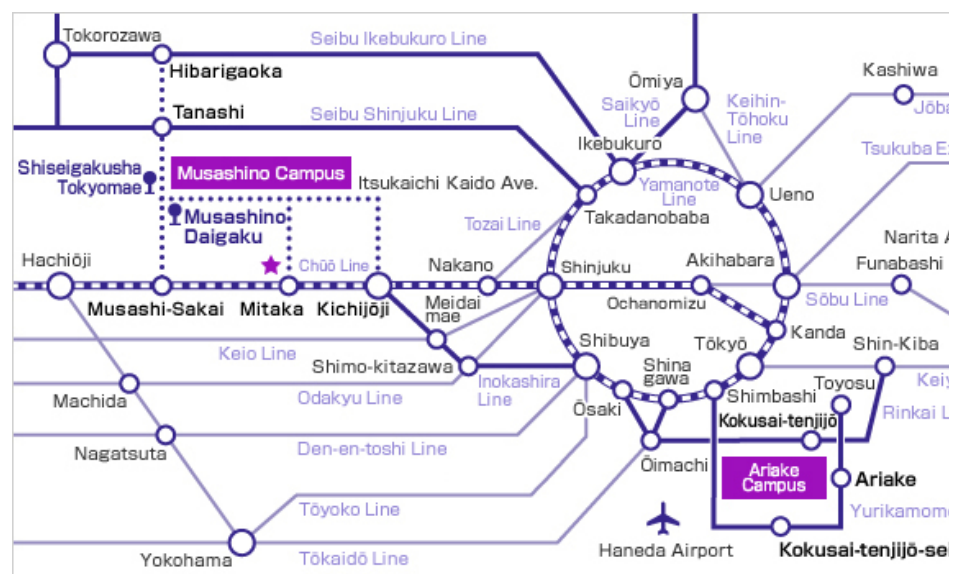
Seibu Shinjuku Line

Get off at Tanashi Station and take the Musashi-sakai-eki bus. After about 5 minutes, get off at Shiseigakusha Tokyomae. Walk for 5 minutes.

Get off at Seibu Yanagizawa Station or Tanashi Station. Walk 15 minutes.

Seibu Ikebukuro Line

Get off at Hibarigaoka Station and take the Musashi-sakai-eki bus. After about 20 minutes, get off at Shiseigakusha Tokyomae. Walk 5 minutes.
